under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving Owner of Automobile

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Jan.  
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wm McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.
