GENTLEMEN:

I hereby make application to your honorable Board for pardon, release, commutation or termination of sentence from a sentence of five months imprisonment in the Box Elder County Jail, in the State of Utah, imposed upon me by the Honorable Judge of the City Court of Brigham City, Box Elder County, Utah, acting as ex-officio Justice of the Peace in and for Box Elder Precinct, on the 9 day of March, A.D. 1923, upon conviction under a charge of petit larceny, to which charge I pleaded guilty. I have already served 58 days of this term; have had ample time to think over the seriousness of my act and realize that a man must pay the penalty of his wrong doing and it is my earnest and sincere intention to be until my dying day a peaceful and law-abiding citizen.

Trusting that your Honorable Body will give to this application and to the accompanying petition and letters or statements in relation to the critical condition of my health, of my attitude, reputation and family's standing, your serious consideration, and thanking you in anticipation for whatever action your sense of right and justice and my own well-being may dictate, this application is
