Application of Jose Aguilar

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Deportation to Mexico and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of Dec. A. D. 1923, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Jas. N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Jas. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jose Aguilar. I was convicted under the name of Jose Aguilar.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Ramon Martinez, Estanislado Macias.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
