Application of Roy C. Scott

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 1st Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of Sept.  
A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Judge Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Roy C. Scott  
I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Men who was acquitted at preliminary hearing

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above
