Application of George Phillips

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of Dec. A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One & Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Roy C. Hutchings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Ray Phillips I was convicted under the name of Sam

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
