First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of Dec.  
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Benson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence  
and to twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Radgus prosecuted the case.
