and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William M. McCrea, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Four Months in the County Jail at Salt
Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of Salt Lake County, Utah,
I began serving time February 21st, 1925, and the term will end
June 20th, 1925.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers, prosecuted the case.
