First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of December A. D. 1922, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Fred Woods presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life Term in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
