Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of February

and State of Utah, in the Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in the State Prison
from one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at Salt Lake City, Utah;
paroled the latter part of June, 1925.

Fourth-- Honorable W. F. Knox and G. H. Lunt prosecuted the case.
