Application of Earl Joseph Disberry

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole or a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary in the 2nd degree & larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of March A. D. 1925, at Brigham City, Box Elder County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in District Court 1st Judicial district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate term of not less than 1 nor more than 20 years and to an indeterminate term of not less than 1 nor more than 10 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison. Prior to that and while awaiting trial I was imprisoned many months in the Box Elder County Jail.

Fourth-- Honorable Le Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Earl Joseph Disberry

I was convicted under the name of Jack Disberry

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: as it appeared in the sheriff's papers John Dwyer, alias Clifford Dwyer Alias John Murphy

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except one and was pardoned My family consists of my wife and six young children now dependent upon the Charities.

The complaint stated 2 causes of action 1st breaking into a harness shop and 2nd stealing \$5.00; 2 saddles; 2 robes; 2 coyote rugs; 4 automobile tires of the value of \$282.00 the personal property of J.H. Keller.

It was a half brother, with whom I was riding to California, who had these goods. He escaped. I sought work to help me along so that I could support my family and while looking for work I was taken. I ask permission to make a personal statement to the Hon. State Board of Pardons.
