Application of Catarino Martinez.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Manslaughter.

Second -- I was convicted ^{pleaded guilty} and sentenced on the 10th day of April =
A. D. 1923, at Provo, County of Grand
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dilworth presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to be indeterminate
Sentence - from 1 to 10 yrs. with recommendation
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison =
on the 16th day of April 1923.

Fourth -- Honorable Mr. Young of Box Elder County prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Catarino Martinez
I was convicted under the name of Catarino Martinez.

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: No one -

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except this -
Dear Sirs in my trouble which was
forced upon me - I had to act in self
defense - I gave my self over to the Sheriff's
office at once - and before the court I plead
guilty to manslaughter with the recommendation
