Application of Ray Manley

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of Dec
A. D. 1922, at St George County of Washington
and State of Utah, in fifth 5th Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one year to
twenty
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable W. M. B. Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Raymond Manley.

I was convicted under the name of Raymond Manley.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Floyd E. Harris

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 14 months in
Reformatory school.

Remarks.

I am asking for Termination owing to the
fact that the Federal People are admitting my
Release from this Prison thanking your Honours.
