I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of Dec.
A. D. 1922, at St. George, Utah County of Wash.
and State of Utah, in 5th district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate 1 to 20
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Wm B. Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Raymond Manley

I was convicted under the name of Raymond Manley

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Floyd E. Harris

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 14 months
in reformatory at Lone Calif.

Remarks: I am applying for a
termination in order to face a
Gov't charge that is now pending.
