and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knod presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-- Honorable William D. Higgins prosecuted the case.
