Application of Andrew Duran

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2<sup>d</sup> Degree of Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of July  
A. D. 1924, at Provo County of Utah  
and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable M. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Andrew Duran

I was convicted under the name of Andrew Duran
