Application of Frank F. Fore

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of June
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District

Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morris L. Richie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of
from one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Fairfield Fore
I was convicted under the name of Frank F. Fore

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
