County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Louis Brown presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Wilson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of M. V. Montia
