Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May

A. D. 1925, at  Ogden  County of  Weber   
and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve in the State Prison for not  
less than three months nor more than two years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison on the
