Application of Andrew Johnson No.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Weber County, Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault and Battery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of March A. D. 1934, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six Months and thereafter was imprisoned in the Weber County, Jail

Fourth-Honorable Wade M. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Andrew Johnson I was convicted under the name of Andrew Johnson
