To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of March  
A. D. 1925, at Price, Utah County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.  
Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 10 years to life.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable O. K. Clay prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Martinez

I was convicted under the name of Tom Martinez

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am  
now serving.
