First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of March
A. D. 1925, at Provo Utah County of Iron
and State of Utah, in Provo Iron County Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. H. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 year to 20 years in
State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. A. Lay prosecuted the case.
