Application of L. E. Riggs

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows: (Conditional if the Board thinks best)

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of February A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is L. E. Riggs I was convicted under the name of L. E. Riggs

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: E. A. Harrison and E. C. Clark

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Uttering a fictitious check
