Application of Larry E. Riggs.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of February A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Larry E. Riggs. I was convicted under the name of " " "

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: E. C. Clark and E. A. Harrison.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Uttering fictitious check, in Colorado.
