Application of L. E. Riggs.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~Conditional~~ termination. On condition that I go to my home in Va. and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of Feb. A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Larry E. Riggs. I was convicted under the name of Larry E. Riggs.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: E. C. Clark and E. A. Harrison

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Uttering fictitious check
