Application of L. E. Riggs.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence (or parole) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of Feb. A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term of five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is L. E. Riggs. I was convicted under the name of L. E. Riggs.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: E. A. Harrison, E. C. Clarke

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Uttering of fictitious check, (State of Colorado)
