under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Eleventh day of August  
A. D. 1922, at Farmington County of Davis  
and State of Utah, in The Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Serve from 1 to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Atty. J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.
