Application of Al. Ringling.

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of February A. D. 1921, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7 Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Delworth Wooly presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life Imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Alfred Ringling I was convicted under the name of Al Ringling
