Application of Clyde Jackson

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon or Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Heber County Jail
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Petty Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of October
A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Heber
and State of Utah, in District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Ninty Days
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Heber County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Clyde Walter Jackson
I was convicted under the name of Clyde Jackson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
