This defendant was held to the district court  
for trial on the charge of Robbery.

In the district court he pleaded guilty to Grand  
Larceny. My recommendation is that he be imprisoned for a  
minimum of five years.

He had just served 18 months at Leavenworth when  
he came to Ogden; and had only been out of that prison about  
eleven days when he held up C. R. Wane, then a railroad  
man, and took from his person a gold watch. The watch was  
in his possession at the time of his arrest.
