State v. Lawrence Hamilton.

Honorable State Board of Pardons,
Salt Lake City.

Gentlemen:

I have received two letters from Lawrence Hamilton imploring me to make a recommendation of leniency in his case. Among other things to induce me to make such a recommendation, he represented to me in one of his letters that he did not hold up any person but that the person from whom he took the goods involved in this case gave it to him for the purpose of enabling him to raise money.

After receiving that letter I had the District Attorney of this District communicate with Mr. C. R. Wane, the person who, it was charged, Hamilton held up. In reply to the communication of the District Attorney, Wane wrote the letter which I herewith enclose.

In view of the discrepancy between Hamilton's letter and Wane's, I am not disposed to make any recommendation of leniency at this time.
