under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May  
A. D. 1921, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in 2<sup>nd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge James H. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An Indeterminate sentence  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lawrence Hamilton  
I was convicted under the name of Lawrence Hamilton
