Application of Lawrence Hamilton

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Rehearing for Termination, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Second day of May A. D. 1921, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimbell presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence of One To Ten Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah, State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lawrence Hamilton. I was convicted under the name of Lawrence Hamilton.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except One Government Charge
