Application of Archibald Joseph McEwan

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the first day of February  
A. D. 1923, at Billmore County of Millard  
and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a term from six month  
to three years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Wiggins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Archibald Joseph McEwan  
I was convicted under the name of Archibald Joseph McEwan

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
