

to this court by Frank W. Frailey, a committing magistrate of said county to answer to this charge, is accused by E. A. Rogers, District Attorney of the Third Judicial District of the State of Utah, in and for Tooele County, by this information, of the crime of forgery committed as follows, to-wit:

That the said C. C. Clarke on the 8th day of March, 1924, at the County of Tooele, State of Utah, wilfully, unlawfully, falsely, feloniously and with intent to defraud the Tooele Auto Service Company, a partnership organized and doing business at Tooele, Utah, to a certain bank check, the tenor whereof is as follows, to-wit:

FARMERS STATE BANK.

Pay to the order of Tooele Otto Service %65.00
Sixty Five xx / 100 Dollars.

C. C. Carter

and endorsed on the back thereof "Tooele Auto Service Co. 4296."

Did forge and counterfeit the name C. C. Carter; contrary to the provisions of the statute aforesaid in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Utah.

Second Count.

Did commit the further crime of forgery as follows, to-wit:

That the said C. C. Clarke at the time and place aforesaid, wilfully, unlawfully, falsely, feloniously and knowing the same to be false, forged, counterfeited and
