Pay to the order of Tooele Auto Service \$65.00
Sixty Five xx / 100 Dollars.

Contrary to the provisions of the statute of the State aforesaid in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Utah.

THE COURT: You are entitled to further time, at least one day, if you desire to take it, to plead to the charge contained in this information, and to plead means to say whether you are guilty or not guilty. Do you want to take the time allowed by law, or are you ready to plead now?

THE DEFENDANT: I am ready to plead, and I will waive ~~time~~ all rights, and enter a plea of guilty.

THE COURT: Let the record show that the defendant waives further time to plead, and that the plea of guilty is entered.

You are entitled to further time, at least two days, before the court shall pronounce judgment upon your plea, if you desire to take it.

THE DEFENDANT: No sir, I am ready for sentence.
