Application of Martin J. Wise

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Dec. 22, day of 1922 A. D., at Ordegn County of Weber and State of Utah, in Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. N. Kimble, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to ten years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Martin J. Wise I was convicted under the name of Martin J. Wise
