Application of Raymond Barrett

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination, subject to
and respectfully represent as follows: New York authorities, for violation of parole.

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the Third day of October,
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the state prison.

Fourth -- Honorable E. H. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Edward Frederick
I was convicted under the name of Raymond Barrett.

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny,
in the state of New York.
