Application of H. L. Akers

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am ~~serving a term of imprisonment~~ ^{on parole} in charge of J. Leo Brown East Bonedaw Ranches, via Parry Utah being paroled from ~~under~~ conviction and a sentence on a charge of forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20 day of December A. D. 1923, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in Sixth Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. H. Erickson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable H. J. Bates prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Herschel Leon Akers

I was convicted under the name of Herschel Leon Akers

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above with no other exceptions

Eighth-- I was paroled by the Board of Pardons at Salt Lake City, Utah on March 21, 1924, and have made Parole Reports to the Honorable James Devine monthly since my parole.
