Application of Marcos Miera

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of February  
A. D. 1924, at Price, Utah County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Marcos Miera

I was convicted under the name of Marcos Miera

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: J. A. Sanchez and Oscar Connor

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
