Application of Jesus Pallares

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or Pardon and respectfully represent as follows: Termination

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with attempt to murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3th day of May A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term, One to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jesus Pallares I was convicted under the name of Jesus Pallares

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
