Application of Jesus Pallas

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with attempt to kill

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May  
A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jesus Pallas  
I was convicted under the name of Jesus Pallas
