Application of Jesse S. Hunt #4464

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of October  
A. D. 1924, at Castle Dale, Utah County of Emery  
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolly presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Fifteen Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jesse S. Hunt

I was convicted under the name of Jesse S. Hunt

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am  
Now serving.
