Application of John Marshall

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a full pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary in the second degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of November A. D. 1919, at Panguitch County of Garfield and State of Utah, in the Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry N. Hayes presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to the State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. E. Hoffmann prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Marshall
I was convicted under the name of Henry John Marshall

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joseph A. Marshall

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one named
