Application of James William Douglas No. 4964

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of Jan.
A. D. 1928, at Brigham City County of Boxelder
and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James William Douglas
I was convicted under the name of Jimmy Douglas

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
and second degree burglary in Sept. 1924
