Application of Frank N. Cape

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of November
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. H. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence
of from one (1) to (5) five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Pros. Atty. E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Francis N. Cape
I was convicted under the name of Frank N. Cape

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery
