First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of October A. D. 1922, at County of Millard and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Cristobal Maciel

I was convicted under the name of Ditto
