First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in San Marcos Parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the — day of April
A. D. 1914, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. A. Howell presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to Life Imprisonment
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable John C. Davis prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Joseph Henry Martin
I was convicted under the name of " " "

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except Assault with
intent to do bodily harm and The Robbery
charge both cases being tried by the same court

but have given the facts as I can remember them.
