and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March  
A. D. 1925, at Price, Utah County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one year to twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Judge J. Christensen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Clarence Howard  
I was convicted under the name of Clarence Howard

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Perry Booth

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
