Application of Clarence Howard

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of March A. D. 1925, at Price, County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison until July 1st, 1925

Fourth-- Honorable O. K. Clay prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Clarence G. Howard I was convicted under the name of same
