Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 August day of Friday A. D. 1924, at Ogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second district Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to not less than one or more than twenty and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable J. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Clifford Jackson I was convicted under the name of Clifford Jackson
